

AGGIE DAYS - STAMPEDE Honey show

April 2017

Rules and Regulations

There will be four categories judged: Liquid Light, Liquid Dark, Creamed/Crystallized, Taster Choice.

Exhibitors may submit one entry in each class.
Each entry will be made up of one jar.

The honey jar should be approximately 375 ml in volume (approximately 500 grams), made of clear glass, and have a one-piece metal lid. Marks will be deducted for jars that cause the judge's view of the honey to be obscured.

Honey exhibitors shall be bona fide beekeepers with entries of pure honey from their own personal apiaries from production of the most recent crop year

Exhibitors must accurately complete the entry form and clearly mark each entry parcel with their name and address. An entry form will accompany each jar. Judges will ensure the entries are placed in the appropriate classes.

Entries must be free of labels.

There is no entry fee.

Show judges shall consider any contestant ineligible if the entry fails to comply with the exhibit criteria or is unattractively displayed.

Awards will be made by a scale of points and, in the case of a tie, the highest score for flavour will be awarded the extra point.

Entries will be retained and become the property of the Calgary and District Beekeepers Association.
